DAY 1 - 29 MAY

Johannesburg.

DAY 2 – 30 MAY CAPE TOWN

(Meals On Board / Lunch / Dinner) Welcome to South Africa. Upon arrival, embark on a city tour of the beautiful " Mother City " Cape Town. See the diversity of the Cape within the city, drive past the House of Parliament, the Edwardian style City Hall, the 17th century Castle of Good Hope, the Slave Quarter, and the Company's Garden . Visit one of the most photographed areas of the city, Bo Kapp (Malay Quarter) fill with brightly painted houses and quaint cobbled streets. Continue the tour with a visit to the landmark of the city, Table Mountain. Take the rotating cable car to the submit of the mountain where you will enjoy the panoramic views of the city, The Devil's Peak, Signal Hill, and the Atlantic Ocean.

DAY 3 - 31 MAY CAPE PENINSULA (Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner)

After breakfast, proceed for a Cape Peninsula tour. A scenic drive through Sea Point and will bring you to Camps Bay for a photo stop with the Twelve Apostles flanking on the west side of Table Mountain. Continue to Hout Bay, a port in small town with spectacular setting of mountains, bay, and ocean. Enjoy a 30-minute boat ride off the port to Duiker Island for seals watching. Make your way along Chapman's Peak Drive, one of South Africa's most spectacular coastal routes (subject to weather permitting). Continue to Fish Hoek, a coastal town of the city popular for holiday makers and retirees. Here in Fish Hoek enjoy a Lobster Lunch. A short drive to Simon Town, visit Boulders Beach, known for its home to a breeding colony of African Penguins. Thereafter, visit Muizenburg Beach, most famous for its long, white sand beach, reliable surf breaks, and colourful beach huts.





DAY 4 - 1 JUN CAPE PENINSULA (Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner)

After breakfast, proceed to Cape point Nature Reserve. Drive along False Bay to the Cape of Good Nature Reserve before Hope reaching Cape Point and ascend to the highest point. Continue to visit an Ostrich farm for a guided tour to learn more about the lifecycle of an Ostrich from egg to adult bird. Thereafter, travel to Constantia for a wine pairing lunch at a local restaurant. After lunch, proceed to Groot Constantia for a guided wine tasting and cellar tour. Dinner will be served at a Thai restaurant.



DAY 5 - 2 JUN CAPE TOWN

(Breakfast / Lunch)

After breakfast, proceed to visit the Two Oceans Aquarium, which fascinating provides а and glimpse closeup below the of the surface oceans that South **African** surround the coastline. Immerse yourself in the enchanting world of the Two Oceans Aquarium in Cape Town where the oceans come alive in magnificent colours and a variety of shapes and sizes. Thereafter, proceed to Victoria & Alfred waterfront for some shopping at leisure. In the late afternoon. proceed to Signal Hill - the best sunset spot in Cape Town.





DAY 6 - 3 JUN CAPE TOWN - VICTORIA FALLS (Box Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner)

Says goodbye to the Mother City and transfer to the airport for our flight to Victoria Falls Airport. Upon arrival transfer to hotel for lunch and check in. Relax in the hotel until the late afternoon, depart for a Sunset Cruise on the Zambezi River, relax, and unwind in the timeless environment while enjoying complimentary drinks and light snacks. The Zambezi's waters above the falls are home to crocodiles, hippo, and other wildlife. Enjoy the crew and the hospitality with a guide font knowledge on the river wildlife, you may even have a chance to listen with tales. local culture, and historical exploration. Have an enjoyable Boma Dinner fun tonight.

Note: In The event if Cape Town no flights to Victoria Falls, group have to fly to JNB and connect their flight to Victoria Falls. Victoria Falls tour can be conducted either Zimbawe or Zambia side depends on flights and hotels availability

DAY 7 - 4 JUN VICTORIA FALLS

(Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner)

Start the day on a guided tour to see the magnificent Victoria Falls. Victoria Falls is one of the Seven Natural Wonders of the World. The noise of the Falls can be heard from 40 kilometres while the mist from the falling waters rise to a height over 400 meters, hence it is known by the local as " Mosi-oa Tunya ", meaning " the smoke that thunders ". It lies on the boundary between Zimbawe and Zambia in Southern Africa. Be awed by its mighty presence. Next proceed to a local art and crafts centre near the Falls. The rest of the day free at leisure to explore more of Victoria Falls.

Note: You may want to go for Helicopter Flight (USD265) to see the Falls at your own expenses.











DAY 8 - 5 JUN VICTORIA FALL - KRUGER NATIONAL PARK (Breakfast / Dinner)

Transfer to Victoria Falls Airport for flight to Kruger Mpumalanga Airport. Upon arrival transfer to the biggest game reserve in South Africa, Kruger National Park. The park is almost two million hectares, it offers visitors a diverse collection of animal species, including the Big Five. Proceed to Shishangeni Private Lodge, a 15,000-ha private concession in the southeastern section of the Kruger National Park. In the late afternoon, proceed for a late afternoon game drive. Dinner will be served at the lodge.







DAY 9 - 6 JUN KRUGER NATIONAL PARK (Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner)

In the early morning, proceed for a morning game drive in an open 4x4 safari jeep in search of wildlife and the Big Five. Enjoy early morning and late afternoon game drives in search of the 'Big 5' with an expert guide. The world-renowned Kruger National Park offers a wildlife experience that ranks with the best in Africa and is best known for the 'Big Five' - imagine taking in a magnificent sunset whilst you capture the moment of a pride of lions stalking their prey or possibly buffalo or watching а elephant strolling to a water hole. Lunch and dinner will be served at the lodge.

DAY 10 - 7 JUN

GAME LODGE - PANORAMA ROUTE - JOHANNESBURG

(Breakfast / Lunch)

This morning, we will leave the and travel back lodge Johannesburg via the popular Panorama Route with the locals. Stop at the Blyde River Canyon - a site of natural phenomena. It is the largest Green Canyon in the world, stretches over 26 kilometres and over 800 meters deep. The canyon passes a rock formation known as the Three Rondavels as it resembles three African style houses. The Zenith of the panorama route -God's Window is a picturesque viewpoint due to the sheer natural beauty. Next stop, see magnificent rock formation known as " Bourke's Luck Potholes " These potholes have been carved pebbles swirling around in the pools where the Blyde and Treur River meet and become one. Continue to Johannesburg after lunch.











DAY 11 – 8 JUN JOHANNESBURG

(Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner)

After breakfast, proceed to Lesedi Cultural Village for a guided tour. Five cultures in a day, that's what we'll be exploring at the Lesedi Cultural Village, heart, and home to families of a range of African tribes, all-living harmoniously in true traditional homesteads. You'll be right there experiencing the warmth hospitality of people from the Zulu, Xhosa, Ndebele, Sotho and Pedi cultures, and you'll find it fascinating! multilingual, multi-visual orientation depicts the history of South Africa, and will deepen your understanding of the complexity of multicultural community. our Thereafter, proceed for lunch at Mall of Africa. After lunch, you can spend some time at Mall of Africa or proceed to visit Nelson Mandela for some last-minute Square shopping.
