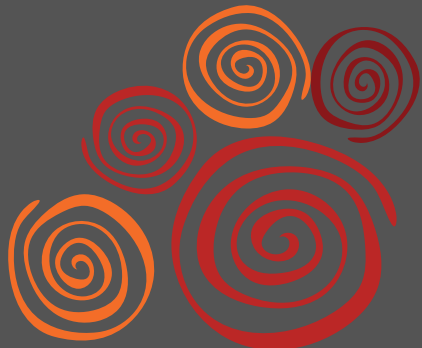

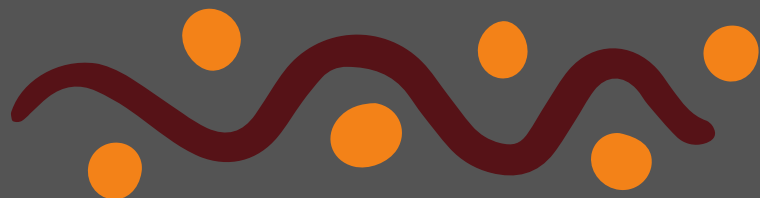

DAY 1 – 04JUN

SINGAPORE ✈ CAPE TOWN

Assemble at Singapore Changi Airport for your flight to Cape Town via Johannesburg.



DAY 2 – 05JUN

CAPE TOWN

(Meals On Board / Lunch / Dinner)

Welcome to South Africa. Upon arrival, embark on a city tour of the beautiful "Mother City" Cape Town. See the diversity of the Cape within the city, drive past the House of Parliament, the Edwardian style City Hall, the 17th century Castle of Good Hope, the Slave Quarter, and the Company's Garden. Visit one of the most photographed areas of the city, Bo Kapp (Malay Quarter) filled with brightly painted houses and quaint cobbled streets. Continue the tour with a visit to the landmark of the city, Table Mountain. Take the rotating cable car to the summit of the mountain where you will enjoy the panoramic views of the city, The Devil's Peak, Signal Hill, and the Atlantic Ocean.

Note:

Table Mountain - Strictly subject to weather permitting, in the event unable to ascend, no replacement



DAY 3 – 06JUN

CAPE PENINSULA

(Breakfast / Lunch / Abalone Chinese Dinner)

After breakfast, proceed for a Cape Peninsula tour. A scenic drive through Sea Point and will bring you to Camps Bay for a photo stop with the Twelve Apostles flanking on the west side of Table Mountain. Continue to Hout Bay, a small town with a port in a spectacular setting of mountains, bay, and ocean. Enjoy a 30-minute boat ride off the port to Duiker Island for seals watching. Make your way along Chapman's Peak Drive, one of South Africa's most spectacular coastal routes (subject to weather permitting). Continue to Fish Hoek, a coastal town of the city popular for holiday makers and retirees. Here in Fish Hoek enjoy a Lobster Lunch. A short drive to Simon Town, visit Boulders Beach, known for its home to a breeding colony of African Penguins. Thereafter, visit Muizenburg Beach, most famous for its long, white sand beach, reliable surf breaks, and colourful beach huts.



DAY 4 – 07JUN

CAPE PENINSULA

(Breakfast / Wine-pairing Lunch)

After breakfast, proceed to Cape point Nature Reserve. Drive along False Bay to the Cape of Good Hope Nature Reserve before reaching Cape Point and ascend to the highest point. Continue to travel to Constantia for a wine pairing lunch at a local restaurant. After lunch, proceed to Groot Constantia for a guided wine tasting and cellar tour. In the late afternoon, proceed to Signal Hill – the best sunset spot in Cape Town.



DAY 5 – 08JUN CAPE TOWN - HERMANUS



(Breakfast / Lunch / Thai Dinner)

After breakfast, travel along the scenic coastal route to the fishing village of Hermanus, known for its stunning ocean views and seasonal whale sightings (June–November). Visit the Abalone Farm at Hermanus' New Harbour for a guided tour to learn about abalone farming and conservation, followed by an abalone tasting experience.

Enjoy lunch at Bientang's Cave Restaurant, set by the sea, then spend some free time exploring the charming town. Return to Cape Town in the afternoon. If time permits, stop at Lagoon Beach to enjoy the sunset. End the day with dinner at a Thai restaurant before heading back to the hotel.

DAY 6 – 09 JUN CAPE TOWN - KRUGER

(Breakfast / Dinner)

Transfer to Cape Town Airport for flight to Kruger Mpumalanga Airport. Upon arrival transfer to the biggest game reserve in South Africa, Kruger National Park. The park is almost two million hectares, it offers visitors a diverse collection of animal species, including the Big Five. Proceed to Shishangeni Private Lodge, a 15,000-ha private concession in the south-eastern section of the Kruger National Park.



DAY 7 – 10 JUN KRUGER NATIONAL PARK (Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner)

In the early morning, proceed for a morning game drive in an open 4x4 safari jeep in search of wildlife and the Big Five. Enjoy early morning and late afternoon game drives in search of the 'Big 5' with an expert guide. The world-renowned Kruger National Park offers a wildlife experience that ranks with the best in Africa and is best known for the 'Big Five' - imagine taking in a magnificent sunset whilst you capture the moment of a pride of lions stalking their prey or possibly watching a buffalo or elephant strolling to a water hole. Lunch and dinner will be served at the lodge. In the evening, proceed for another game drive.



DAY 8 – 11 JUN

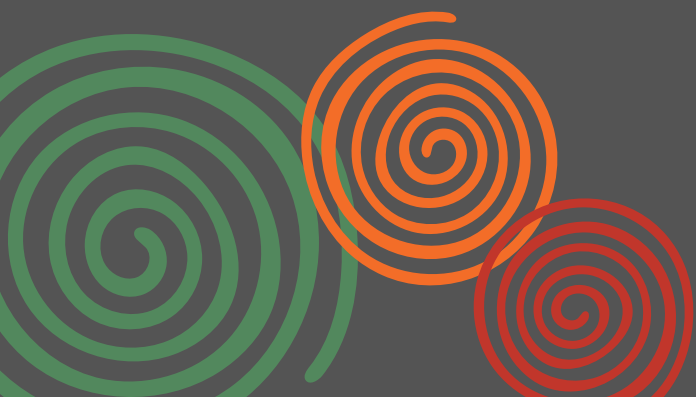
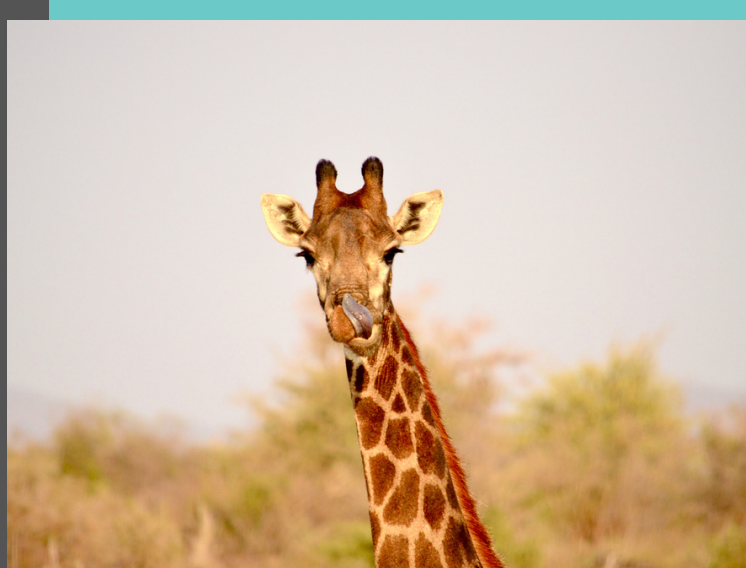

In the early morning, depart the game lodge for your transfer to Kruger Mpumalanga International Airport for your flight to Victoria Falls Airport. Upon arrival transfer to hotel for lunch and check in. Relax in the hotel until the late afternoon, depart for a Sunset Dinner Cruise on the Zambezi River, relax and unwind in the timeless environment while enjoying dinner. The Victoria Falls Dinner Cruise is truly exceptional. Not only do you get to witness the natural beauty of the river at dusk, but you also enjoy a gourmet three-course dinner prepared with care and attention to detail. 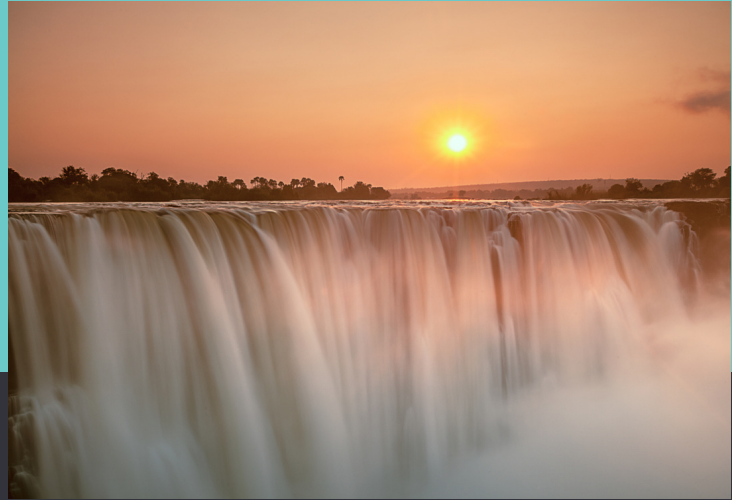
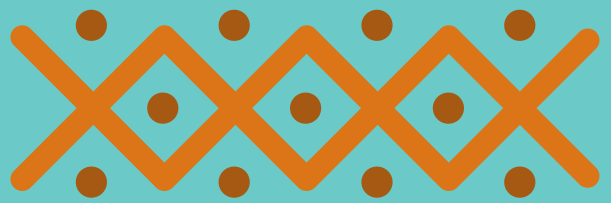


DAY 9 – 12 JUN VICTORIA FALLS

(Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner)

In the early morning, start the day on a guided sunrise tour to see the magnificent Victoria Falls – Zimbabwe Side. Victoria Falls is one of the Seven Natural Wonders of the World. The noise of the Falls can be heard from a distance of 40 kilometres while the mist from the falling waters rise to a height over 400 meters, hence it is known by the local as "Mosi-oa-Tunya", meaning "the smoke that thunders". It lies on the boundary between Zimbabwe and Zambia in Southern Africa. Be awed by its mighty presence. Thereafter, proceed to the Lookout Café for breakfast. After breakfast, we cross the Victoria Falls bridge to Livingstone (Zambia). We visit the Falls from the Zambian side, and when it's in full flow, you'll experience the showers from the crushing Falls below. Raincoats needed. Please Note: The Falls on the Zambian side may dry out seasonally (Sep - Dec). Proceed for lunch at a western restaurant. After lunch, I travel back to Victoria Falls. The rest of the day free at leisure to explore more of Victoria Falls. You may want to go for Bungee Jump, Gorge Swing, Helicopter Flight to see the Falls and more at your own expenses.

Note: You may want to go for Helicopter Flight (approximately USD265) to see the Falls at your own expenses .



DAY 10 – 13 JUN VICTORIA FALLS - JOHANNESBURG (Breakfast / Dinner)

After breakfast, morning is free at leisure. Transfer to Victoria Falls Airport for your flight to Johannesburg. On arrival in O.R Tambo airport, proceed to Mall of Africa for some shopping. Dinner will be served at Kream Restaurant.



DAY 11 – 14 JUN JOHANNESBURG

(Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner)

After breakfast, proceed to Rosebank rooftop Sunday Market (only on Sundays). Thereafter proceed for some shopping and lunch at a Chinese restaurant. After lunch, proceed to Soweto. It's a legend. SOWETO, an acronym for Southwestern Township, is home to over 2 million people, who, despite living in crowded and chaotic conditions, have a tangible sense of community, one which ironically, the ordered, walled, elitist northern suburbs lack. Inside Soweto, guests visit the Kliptown Open Air Museum, located at Walter Sisulu Square (UNESCO – Human Rights, Liberation and Reconciliation: Nelson Mandela Legacy Sites), where delegates met in 1955 to adopt the Freedom Charter, now the cornerstone of the Bill of Rights and the South African Constitution. The next stop is the Hector Pieterse Museum and discover the cause of the tragic riots which led to his death; guests will drive past Mandela House and give you time to visit this fascinating little museum. Return to Sandton for dinner.



DAY 12 – 15 JUN
JOHANNESBURG - SINGAPORE
(Breakfast)

After a leisure breakfast, proceed to Lesedi Cultural Village for a guided tour. Five cultures in a day, that's what we'll be exploring at the Lesedi Cultural Village, heart and home to families of a range of African tribes, all-living harmoniously in true traditional homesteads. You'll be right there experiencing the warmth and hospitality of people from the Zulu, Xhosa, Ndebele, Sotho and Pedi cultures, and you'll find it fascinating! Our multilingual, multi-visual orientation depicts the history of South Africa and will deepen your understanding of the complexity of our multicultural community. Thereafter, proceed to Emperor Palace Casino complex for some free time. Transfer to O.R Tambo International Airport for your flight back to Singapore

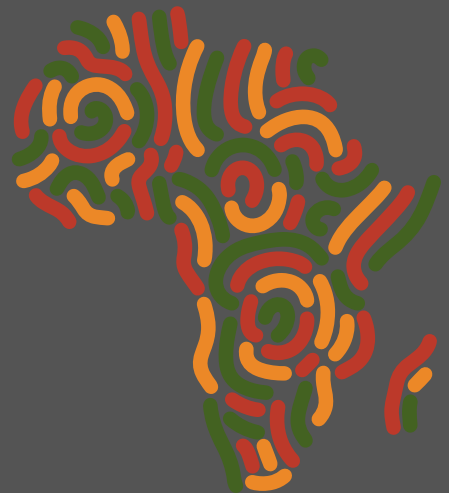
